




 Another fascinating thing is that the paintings at Ivanovo are all original and un-restored from the 13th century.






• It was nice to see how much attention is paid to the reconstruction of the medieval cities and capitals.





• The Krushuna waterfalls can take your breath away.








- Caves are arranged for visitors, even for those with no experience.
